You may notice your child's energy levels or mood differ this time of year. With winter break, vacations, and the holidays, children are adapting to changes in their daily routine and diet. First, it is important for your child to understand that we feel our best when we eat wholesome foods. Many children can name foods that are good for them but may not always know what benefits they have for our bodies.

Food group	What should I choose?	Benefits to my body
Fruits	Bright and colorful fresh or frozen fruits.	Helps reduce risk of heart disease, stroke and type 2 diabetes.
Vegetables	A mix of veggies, including ones that are dark green, red and orange, as well as beans, peas and more.	Helps reduce risk of heart disease, can help lower cholesterol and may help maintain healthy blood pressure.
Grains	Grains like whole wheat, brown rice, quinoa and oatmeal. Make half the grains you eat whole grains.	Helps reduce risk of type 2 diabetes, improves digestion and can help maintain or lower weight.
Protein foods	Lean proteins like fish and poultry, beans and nuts, soy foods like tofu.	Help form red blood cells, build healthy bones and muscles.
Dairy	Low-fat or fat-free dairy, like milk, yogurt, cheese and fortified soy drinks.	Helps reduce risk of osteoporosis and can lower blood pressure.

STUDENT SERVICES UPDATES

Bright Futures Evaluations

During the week of November 14, seniors were given the opportunity to stop by the guidance office and pick up their Bright Futures evaluations. The evaluation is current only up to the date listed on the paper. Seniors should use this information as a tool. It gives them an idea of what tasks they need to complete to qualify for a Bright Futures scholarship.

Many students noticed that their evaluations indicated that they had not applied for the scholarship. **EVERY STUDENT, regardless of their post-secondary plans, should complete the <u>Florida Financial Aid Application</u> (FFAA). The application is REQUIRED** for Bright Futures scholarships and considers them for multiple state scholarships. Students are encouraged to apply by December 1 regardless of whether they have completed the requirements. Applying now holds their spot to be officially evaluated over the summer. There is no penalty for applying before completing the requirements. Your student should not wait to submit their FFAA.

RESCHEDULED--Tampa Bay Higher Education Alliance College Fair; Steinbrenner Cafeteria

Due to Hurricane Nicole, the college fair that was originally scheduled for November 9 has been rescheduled for **December 15, 6-8pm**. This exciting event will feature colleges and universities from our area as well as from across the state.

Programming

November 18 was the deadline for students to submit their course selection sheets to their English teacher. If a student did not have an English teacher on campus, it was their responsibility to pick up a course selection sheet and submit it to the guidance office by the deadline.

Counselors will begin meeting with Freshmen in December and then Sophomores and Juniors after the winter break. Each English class will be assigned a meeting day. Your student will take advantage of the opportunity to meet with their counselor on this day. If your student is absent on the assigned day or does not have an English class, a counselor will meet with them at a separate time. In this case, their counselor will reach out to them individually for a meeting.

March 10, 2023 is the deadline to make a schedule change request for the 2023-2024 school year. Directions to request changes will be posted on canvas. Schedule change requests should only be submitted if a change is needed AFTER the meeting with their counselor. Otherwise, the change can be discussed during the in-person meeting on their assigned day. Most reasonable and approved requests for changes can be made.

The 2023-2024 class schedules will be created during the summer break. No group or person has priority over another.

FLVS/HVS Co-Enrolled Students

If your student is planning early dismissal for a 2nd semester virtual class, they must register for their course now and set the start date for January 10.

2nd Semester 2023

With the 2nd semester just around the corner, we want to remind families that all students will receive a newly printed schedule sheet when they return from winter break. Even if your student's semester 2 classes have not changed, they will still receive a newly printed schedule.

The only change requests that will be considered are for students that:

- have a duplicate class on their schedule
- are assigned a class they have already taken and passed
- were placed in a class that was not one of their first choice or alternate elective choices

The process for these change requests will be posted in the Guidance section on canvas.

Scholarship Opportunity--Florida Eastern Star Grant Tuition Assistance Program

Deadline is January 1, 2023. This is a one-year scholarship that goes toward tuition. The award amount is determined by the funds available. This scholarship is for seniors that have already been accepted to a university, college, community college, or vocational institution. An essay is required.
